

AQUATICS ADVISORY COMMITTEE REPORT  
REGULAR MEETING  
THURSDAY, OCTOBER 9, 2014, AT 1:30 P.M.

A regular meeting of the Aquatics Advisory Committee (AAC) was called to order by the Vice Chairman, Jo Jones, at 1:30 p.m. on Thursday, October 9, 2014, in the Board Room at Gateway Complex.

Present, in addition to the Vice Chairman, were Susie L. Chiang, Judith L. Morton, Dale O. Reynolds, Brian K. Stack, and Melvin N. Wall, GRF representative and ex-officio member. Norman L. Gorsuch was excused. Also attending were Diane C. Guilfooy, President, and Mary Lou Delpech, Director, GRF Board; Jeffrey P. Matheson, Director of Resident Services; Lisa Ward, Head Coach for the Rossmoor Masters Swim Club, The Silver Bullets; and one resident. Attendance

The Vice Chairman reported that she attended the Fitness Center Advisory Committee meeting and it has selected members for the Joint Subcommittee to work with the AAC's Subcommittee members. Mr. Matheson will work to arrange the first meeting of the Joint Subcommittee. Vice Chairman's Report

Mr. Reynolds presented the pool numbers as of September 2014. It was noted that pool attendance for all pools was up 13.26% from the previous year. It was also noted that the pools are on an annual rate to exceed 110,000 in attendance based upon 9 months of data. If this happens, use for all pools will exceed the 98,744 attendance numbers for the year ending December 2013. Pool Attendance

Mr. Stack announced that he will work with the Rossmoor News to get articles in the paper to remind residents that Hillside and Dollar pools will be open for the entire months of November 2014 and March 2015. He also reported that he continues to work with pool staff regarding articles about the lifeguards. Sub-committee Report

Ms. Ward gave a presentation for a new program titled "Swimming Saves Lives". The program is sponsored by the United States Master Swimming organization and would be fully funded by the Swimming Saves Lives Foundation. The presentation was well received by all Committee members, and it was decided to move forward subject to insurance indemnification and pool availability.
