

AQUATICS ADVISORY COMMITTEE REPORT  
REGULAR MEETING  
THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 13, 2014, AT 1:30 P.M.

A regular meeting of the Aquatics Advisory Committee (AAC) was called to order by the Chairman, Joan R. (Jo) Jones, at 1:30 p.m. on Thursday, November 13, 2014, in the Board Room at Gateway Complex.

Present, in addition to the Chairman, were Dale O. Reynolds, Secretary, Susie L. Chiang, Norman L. Gorsuch, Marilyn Mansfield, Judith L. Morton, Brian K. Stack, and Melvin N. Wall, GRF Board representative and ex-officio member. Also attending were Diane C. Guilfooy, President, GRF; and Jeffrey P. Matheson, Director, Resident Services. Attendance

The report of the Committee's meeting held on October 9, 2014, was approved as presented. Report Approved

The Chairman nominated Mrs. Morton to serve as Vice Chairman of the Committee. Selection of Vice Chairman

A motion was made and seconded to accept the nomination of Judith L. Morton as the Committee's Vice Chairman. A vote on the motion was taken, and the motion CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Mr. Reynolds presented the pool numbers as of October 2014. It was noted that pool attendance for all pools was up 11.60% for the month of October. Dollar pool was up 18.86%, Hillside pool was up 18.33%, and Del Valle pool was up 7.26%. Attendance for all pools in October 2014 was up 6.50% over October 2013. It was also noted that the pools are on an annual rate to exceed 108,000 based upon 10 months of data. If this happens, use for all pools will exceed the 98,744 attendance figure for the year ending December 2013. Pool Attendance

Mr. Stack also gave an update on the progress of implementing the "Swimming Saves Lives" program. The program is due to start in January 2015. The Rossmoor News will provide information regarding the program and instructions to sign up for lessons. Sign-ups will determine the number of instructors needed. The Masters Swim Club will provide private instructors for each resident. Rossmoor is the first senior community in the United States to implement this program. There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 2:26 p.m. Adjournment


