

Dear Mr. Matheson,

A recent article by the Aquatics Chairman recommended and described lane sharing/circle swimming which is predicated on participants being able to consistently swim straight, using the freestyle (crawl) stroke and forces swimmers next to the hard lane buoys or the wall and swimmers in adjacent lanes. It is problematic if not impossible for swimmers doing backstroke, side or breaststroke or butterfly. A safe exercise venue is turned into a daunting swim with potential for injury.

Residents who have MS, Parkinson's, compromised cardiac or respiratory function or otherwise are no longer strong, agile swimmers could be easily overwhelmed by swimmers passing in both directions. Those with osteoporosis or taking anticoagulants shouldn't risk fractures, contusions or bleeding as a result of hitting or kicking hard plastic lane lines. Anyone with recent injuries or surgery should not risk colliding with other swimmers or inadvertently being kicked or struck with other swimmers' fins or hand paddles. Those with poor vision or vertigo shouldn't be forced away from the lane center where dark tile lines and wall crosses aid the swimmer from kicking lines or colliding into walls.

While those who are still spry, powerful swimmers should count their blessings, please be cognizant the Rossmoor demographic is in large part not competitive swim athletes but is coping with health issues and/or aging deficits. The Aquatics Committee should make it absolutely clear no resident should feel selfish, uncomfortable, ashamed, illegitimate or in anyway have to explain themselves if they're using a lane alone.

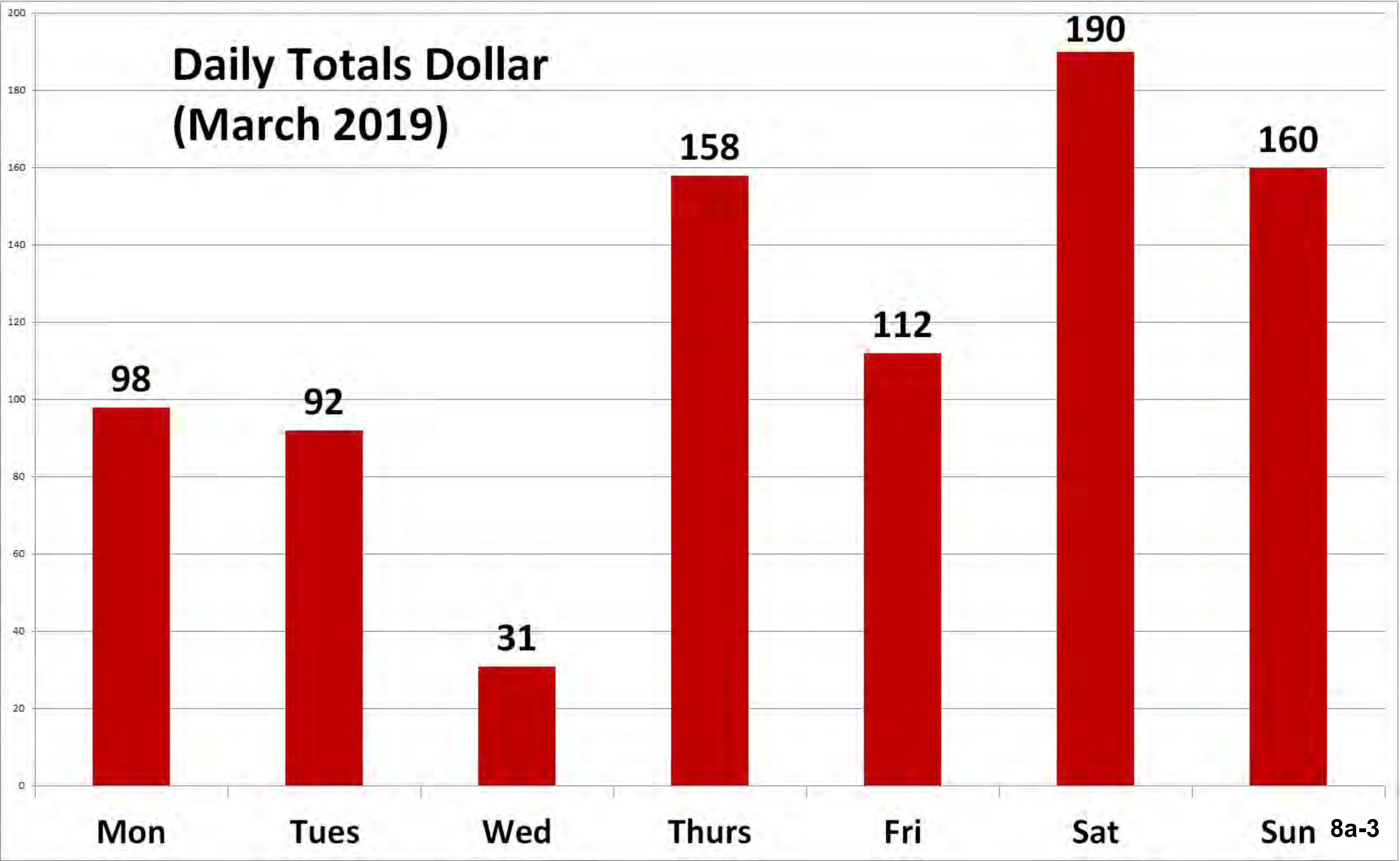

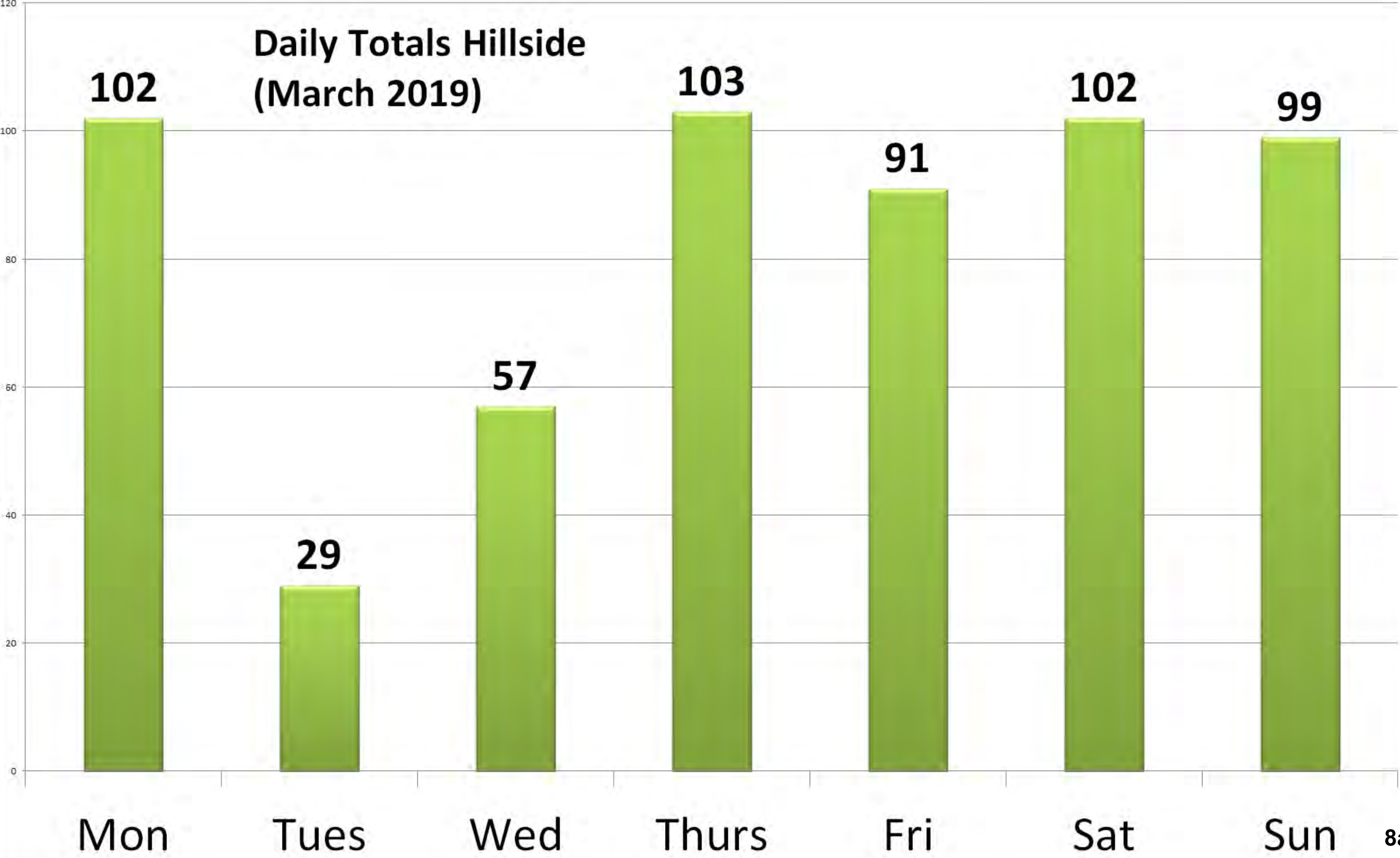

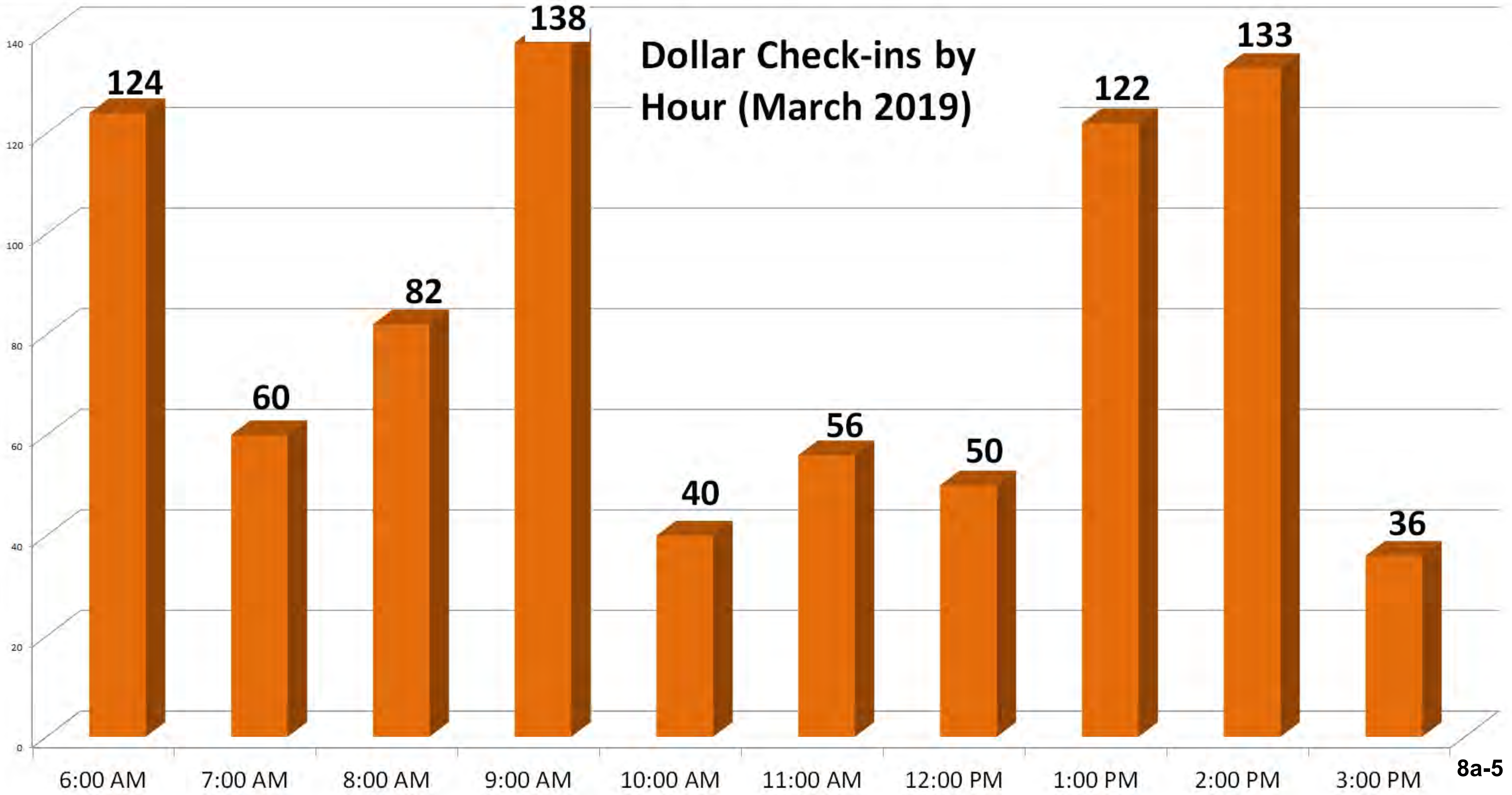
Daily Totals Dollar (March 2019)
